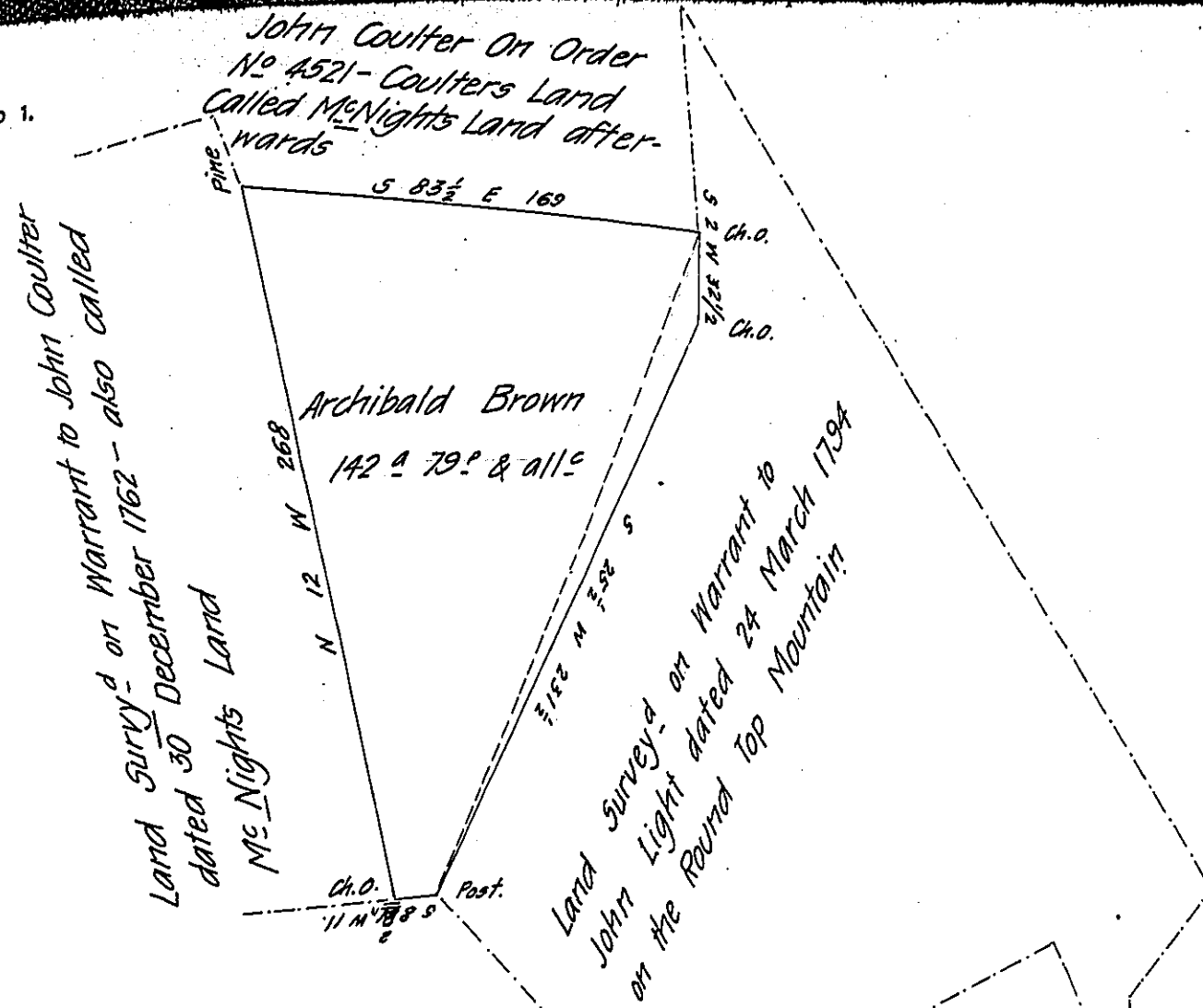

The above tract is covered by the following Office Rights to Wit: - the same appears to be covered by a Survey purporting to be 129 ^a/₄ acres on an Order of Survey to William Wisely dated 17th Dec^r 1767 No 4655 & held under said title confirmed by Patent - the same is also included in a larger tract of 420 Acres 144 perches Survey'd on Warrant to John Light dated 7 March 1794 - the dotted lines represent the balance of Survey on on-Lights Warrant. No evidence of possession in-Brown or of any person claiming under him and some doubts as to the location of the above as the same might be located further South - no Township mentioned in the Order.
