 Report - The above Tract was Survey<sup>d</sup> 21<sup>st</sup> April 1775 on a Warrant to Adam Simon dated 5<sup>th</sup> December 1774 & held under said title - Note no evidence of Samples Order being executed on the land or of any person claiming under the same - Yet the location of Samples Order locates the Land - including the dry Run & a Deer Lick - Owners George Stingers heirs & Adam Stingers heirs & Christian Folt & Christian Bigler Occupants.
