 Report - The above Tract is wholly included within the lines of a larger tract of 273A. 27.P. Survey<sup>d</sup> 16. March 1767 on an Order to Wm Torrence for 150 Acres dated the 4 August 1766 No 734 - The blank lined figure represents the balance of Survey on the last mentioned Order - The Order of the 4<sup>th</sup> Aug: 1766 appears to have been intended to locate Land further South joining Wm Plumsted; Or perhaps the two Orders were intended to cover the whole of the tract; but the Survey has been made & returned on the one as already stated.
