



Situate in West Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 10th day of October 1832 by virtue of an Order of Survey Granted to George Christ dated the third day of April 1769 N^o 1729 Containing three hundred & eighteen Acres with the usual Allowance of six per Cent. &c &c.

Note: The same tract of land Contains two surveys one thereof Surveyed the 15th day of June 1771 for Samuel Davis in pursuance of his order dated the 19th day of June 1769 Number 3514 Containing 177 acres &c &c. The other Surveyed on the day aforesaid for James Johnstone in pursuance of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 1933 Containing one hundred & forty one Acres and allowance &c &c and now owned & in possession of David Watson in right of the said Samuel Davis &c James Johnston.
