



Situate in Buffalo Township Union (late Berks) County surveyed the 8th day of May 1833 by virtue of an Order Granted to Peter Bragth dated the 3^d day of April 1769 No 2336 containing one hundred & sixty three acres with the usual allowance &c.

Note The same tract of land was surveyed the 4th day of October 1769 for Andrew Culbertson in pursuance of his Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 - No. 296 And now owned and occupied by John Cowdan in right of the s^d. Andrew Culbertson.
