



Situate in Buffalo Township Union (late Berks) County surveyed the 1st day of May A.D. 1833 by virtue of an Order No 3361 Granted to Mary Allen dated the 3^d day of April 1769 containing two hundred & seventy one acres with the usual allowance of six Per Cent. &c.

The same was surveyed the 22^d day of March A. D. 1770 for George Palmer by virtue of his order No 422 dated the 3^d day of April A. D. 1769 now owned & occupied by Isaac Eyer in right of the said George Palmer.
