



Situate in Buffalo Township Union (late Berks) County surveyed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1833 by virtue of an Order of Survey granted to Stephen Markwright dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 No. 1133, containing two hundred & seventy one acres with the usual allowance of six & Cent. &c

Note The same tract of land was surveyed the 22<sup>d</sup> day of March 1770 for George Palmer in pursuance of his order of survey dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 No. 422. And now owned & occupied by Isaac Eyer in right of the said George Palmer.
