



Situate in West Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 9th day of October 1832 by virtue of an Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 No 2341, containing three hundred & forty acres & sixty perches — with the usual allowance of six Per Cent. &c.

Note - The same tract of land was the allotment which fell to the share of Lieutenant Stewart according to the agreement of the Officers of Col^l Francis Carps in the division of a tract of 8,000 acres granted to and surveyed for — them in Buffalo Valley in pursuance of an Order No 1 on the 1st, 2^d & 3^d days of March 1769. And now owned & occupied by Robert Forster in right of the said Lieut^t Stewart.
