



Situate in Turbut Township Northumberland County on the south side of Delaware run joining & above John Stephens, about 1/4 miles from the forks of said Run. - Surveyed the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 1835 by virtue of an Order No. 2373 dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1769 containing One hundred & eighty six acres and the all<sup>s</sup> of six Per Cent &c.

Note - The same tract of land was surveyed the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ for Jacob Stout in pursuance of his application dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1769 - No. 1990, and is now owned and occupied by John Lantz, in right of said Jacob Stout.
