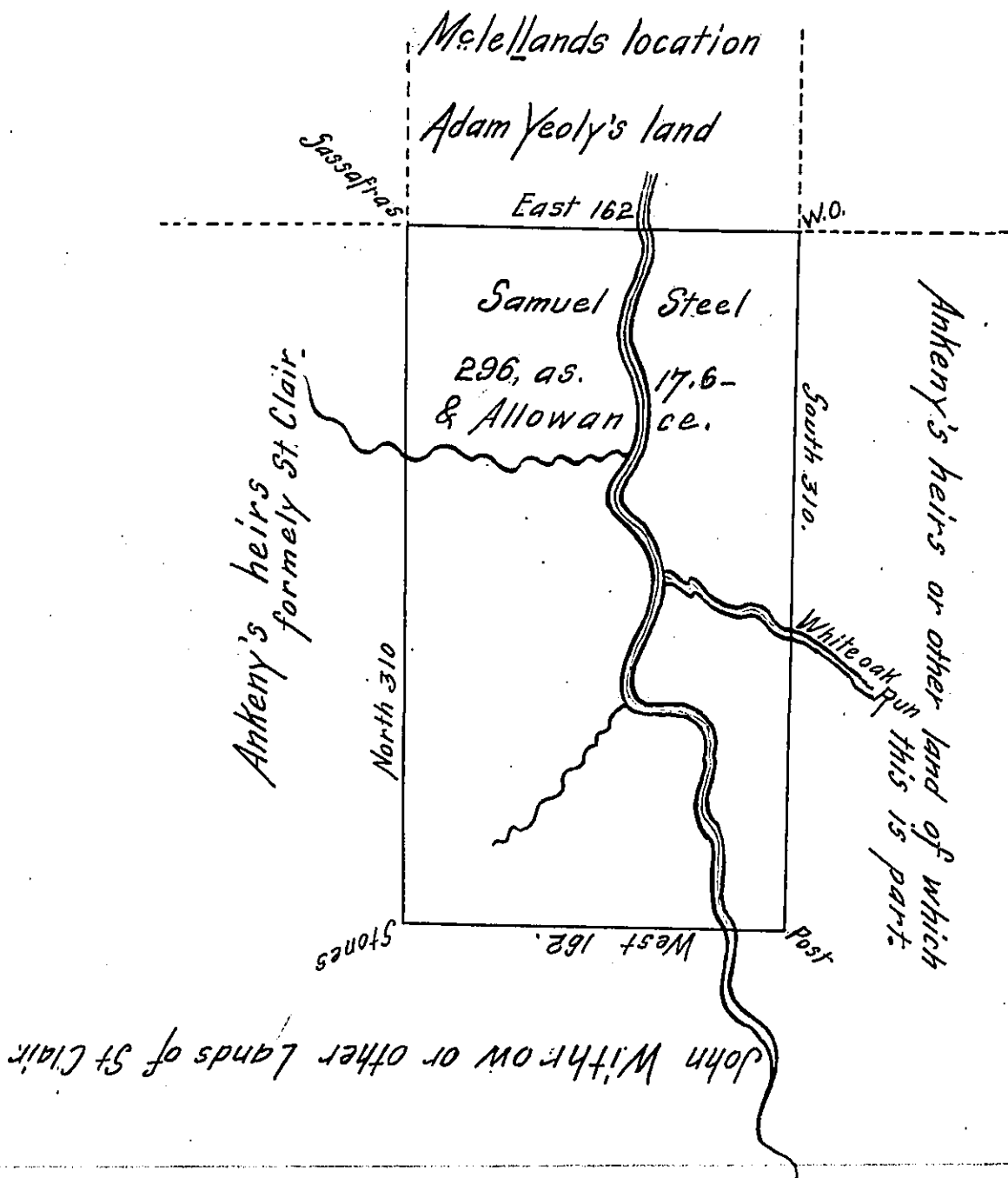

In pursuance of an Application granted to Samuel Steel No. 1052, bearing date 3^d of April 1769, Surveyed on the 19th of January 1829, containing two hundred and ninety six acres, seventeen and six tenths ^{perches}, and the allowance proportioned at six percent for roads &c. Situate on the Loyalhanna creek near the meeting of the waters that form said creek including the noted lick in the bottom in Donegal Township, Westmoreland County Pa.
