



The dotted lines including the letters A.B.C.D. on the above diagram represent a survey made to Samuel Culbertson Jr. on the 22<sup>d</sup> of February 1828. A return whereof is herewith enclosed.

It will be seen by the above diagram that the land for which Samuel Culbertson's Jr. Location was intended has been previously surveyed and appropriated. It is owned by Robert Brown of Greensburgh, Westmoreland County and is Patented to James Campbell except that part which interferes with William Beard which is patented to James Black.
