



Situate in Turbut Township Northumberland County, on a stream leading into the N. Easterly side of the west branch of the Susquehanna, beginning at a fallen w. &. said to have been marked Z.F. which once stood on the bank of said stream.

Surveyed on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1835 by virtue of an order dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1769. No 1575 granted to William Dillwyn, containing three hundred and twelve acres & one hundred & seventeen perches & the usual allowance of six per cent &c.

Note The same tract of land was surveyed for Robert Norris on the day of 17 by virtue of his order dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1769. No. 3492 and is now owned and occupied by Peter Mangas S. Glaz & others in right of said Robert Norris.
