



Situate in Turbut Township, Northumberland County, on the heads of Delaware run at the foot of the Muncy hill, Surveyed on the 26th. day of September, A.D. 1835. by virtue of an application dated the 3d. day of Apl. 1769, No. 1515 granted to John Hutchison. Containing One hundred and Seventy two acres, and the usual allowance of six per cent &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed on the — day of — 1769. for Joseph Rice in pursuance of his order dated the 3d. day of Apl. 1769. No. 3790. and is now owned and occupied by Jacob Hoffman in right of said Joseph Rice.
