



Situate on the south side of the West Branch of the Susquehanna
 —in turkey bottom. Surveyed the 12th. day of November 1835, by virtue
 of an order granted to Margaret Gardner dated the 3d. day of April, 1769.
 No. 1501. Containing two Hundred & ninety one Acres & the usual allow-
 ance &c.

 1769. for John Zemmerman. in pursuance of his order No. 14. dated 3d.
 April, 1769. & now owned by Jacob McCurley & others in right of the
 said John Zemmerman. Jno. Hayes.
