



Pursuant to Contract with the Members of the Board of property of Penna. dated Novr. first 1827. & the authority therein, the above Survey was made &c. by virtue order No. 1547. granted by the proprietary government to Jacob Stopher the 3d. Apl. 1769. containing three hundred thirteen acres, one rood, 22 pr. 4/10. & alls. Situate in St. Clair Township, Allegheny County.

Note. the above Survey includes all the land Executed upon a Virginia Entry in name of Thos. Rankin, Decr. 2d. 1786. on the waters of Chartiers Creek below the East fork.
