



Situate in Buffaloe township Union [late Berks] County. Surveyed the 22d day of October 1832. By virtue of an Order of Survey Granted to Stephen Porter, Dated the 30. day of April, 1769. No. 1464. Containing three hundred and twenty seven acres and twelve perches with the usual allowance &c.
