



Situate in Hartley township Union County, Surveyed the 25th day of July, 1836 by virtue of an Order dated the 3d day of April, 1769. No. 1418. granted to Richard Footman. Containing three Hundred Acres & the Usual Allowance &c. and is represented by the Green lines.

Note. The same interfere's & is included in a Survey made the 29th. of November 1785 for John Snell in pursuance of his warrant Dated 22d. day of September, 1785. & now owned by Philip Seebold in right of the said John Snell & is represented by the Red lines.
