



Situate in Hartleton township Union [late Berks] County. Surveyed the 5th. day of April, 1833 by virtue of an Order of Survey granted to Michael Treaster dated the 3d. day of April, 1769. No. 1295. Containing three hundred & thirty six Acres with the usual Allowance. &c.

Note. The same tract of land was surveyed the 27th day of September, 1770. for the said Michael Treaster by virtue of the same Order viz. No. 1295 by the late William Maclay. D.S.
