



Situate in Kelly township Union [late Berks] County. Surveyed the 5th day of March, 1833 by virtue of an Order granted to John Huling dated the 3d day of April, 1769. No. 835 Containing two hundred and Ninety Acres & Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 17th day of March 1769 for Lieut. McAllister being the Allotment which fell to him on the Division of a tract of 1105 Acres. Surveyed for the Officers of Col. T Francis Corps in pursuance of an Order of Survey dated the 9th day of March, 1769. And now Owned and Occupied by Thomas Howard in right of the said Lieut. McAllister.
