



Situate in Buffalo township Union [late Berks] County. Surveyed the 2d day of October 1832 by virtue of an Order granted to Charles Shaffner dated the 3d day of April, 1769. No. 1204 Containing three hundred & fourteen Acres and Ninety one perches with the Usual Allowance of 6 pr. Cent.
