



Situate in Buffalo township Union [late Berks.] County. Surveyed the 25th day of October 1832 by virtue of an Order granted to Nathaniel Gallispie dated the 3d day of April, 1769. No. 1200. Containing One hundred & eighty five Acres with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 10th day of June 1772 for John McClung in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 6th day of January 1772 And now Owned and Occupied by Alexander Graham in right of the said John McClung.
