The same was Surveyed for William Neil the 17th day of August 1769 in pursuance of his order bearing date the 3d day of April 1769, No. 482. Now held and Owned in separate parts by John Kaufman, James McGhee, Joseph McGhee and Andrew McGhee in right of William Neil.
