



Situate in Buffalo township Union County, Surveyed the 4th day of November, 1832 by virtue of an order Granted to Eberhart Gruber. Dated the 8th. day of April, 1769. No. 2987. Containing One Hundred & thirty seven acres & one hundred & twenty six perches with the usual allowance & Designated by yellow lines. Note. The same tract of land was included in a survey made the 5th day of August, 1769 for Henry Sees in pursuance of his Order Dated 3d. of April, 1769, ^{No. 341} & is Designated by the green lines & is now owned & occupied by Matheas Bechtel in right of the said Henry Sees pr. Jno. Hayes
