by virtue of an Order granted to James Craig dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 2346. Contain-  
ing three hundred and Six Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six P<sup>s</sup> C<sup>t</sup> &c.  
Note The above described tract of land was Surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February 1775 for  
Michael Weyland in pursuance of his Order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 32. Now owned and  
Occupied by James Moore and John Heckle.
