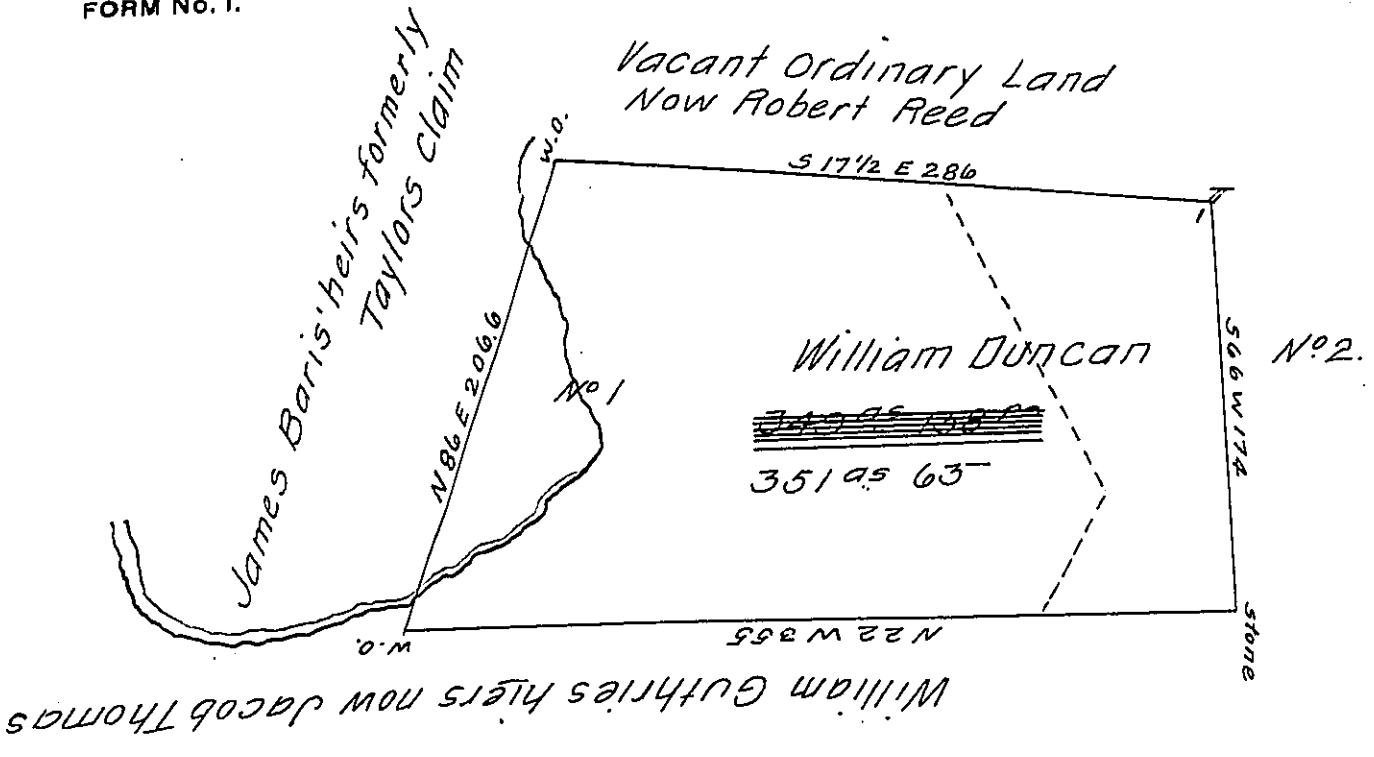

Note) the above land was surveyed on an order No 435 dated 3^d of April 1769. and a patent granted to John Patterson. the part run in was Warranted Samuel Moorhead. ~~the~~ the tract No 1 was claimed by William Duncan and to Decide the claim they resolved to put their personal prowess to the test in Wrestling in which Wilson came off Victorious. and hence the name of Wilson's conquest. Duncan ever afterwards relinquished his claim.
