



Situate on the Waters of Little Juniatta - in Antis township Huntingdon County, containing Three hundred and forty three and one half Acres and allowance. Surveyed for Peter Miller on order N<sup>o</sup> 59, dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1766.

The dotted lines represent part of a Survey made for Elisha Davis on Warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1804 - This Survey interferes Eighty and one half acres with the Peter Miller tract. Elisha Davis conveyed to Gloninger & Co. who had purchased the Peter Miller Tract for Taxes - George Weight Improved part of the Peter Miller tract and sold his Improvement to Gloninger & Co. who claimed under Peter Miller by virtue of a Purchase for taxes.
