Situate on the North branch of Little Juniatta River now Called Little Bald Eagle Creek, about $\frac{3}{4}$ of one mile from Logan's Narrows, In Warrior-Mark township, Huntingdon County, Containing Two hundred and forty nine acres and Sixty nine perches and allowance of Six per Cent. Surveyed for William Grace on order N^o 386 dated the 1st August 1766.

The dotted lines represent part of the draught of a tract of land Surveyed for James Harris on Warrant dated the 8th day of October 1784, this tract interferes two Hundred and forty nine acres and Sixty nine perches with the William Grace Survey—James Harris Conveyed to Barnard Dougherty whose Executor D^r John Anderson conveyed to Gloninger & Co. the present owners.
