Containing one hundred and ninety nine acres and one hundred and fourteen perches and allowance of Six per cent. Surveyed for John Smith on order N^o 1396. dated the 30th day of September 1766.

The dotted and black lines represent the draught of a Survey made for Thomas Weems and John Keer on Warrant dated the 8th day of October 1774. This Survey interferes one Hundred and ninety nine acres and one hundred and fourteen perches with the John Smith tract. Thomas Weems & John Keer conveyed to John Gripe who conveyed to Jacob Shiveley. who conveyed part to Henry Mogle the present owner. the residue he conveyed to M^r Hasle who devised the Same to his widow (who is married to D^r Baker) & his heirs the present owners.
