The red lines represent part of a Survey made for Alexander Mc Cormack on Warrant dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1795 Interest from 1777 - This Survey interferes one hundred and fifty six acres with The Arthur Galbraith tract. this tract was sold from Alexander Mc Cormack by the Sheriff of Huntingdon County to William Oaks the present owner.
