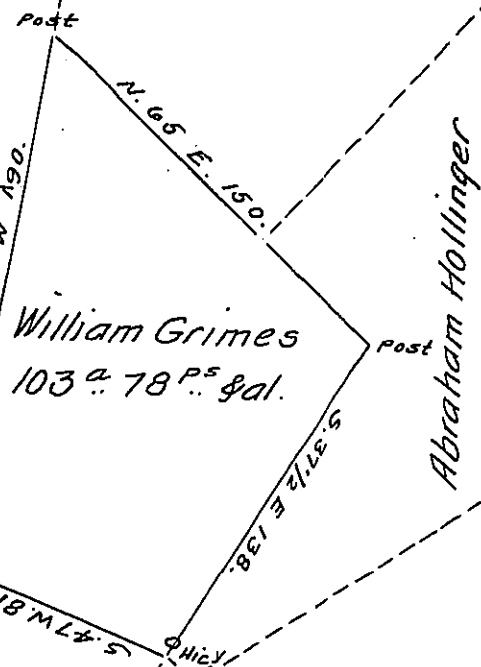


Henry Etters heirs in right of John Forsyth on Wart. 22^d July 1742.

In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of Assembly relating to unpatented Lands under proprietary Rights &c. And by Virtue of an Order of Survey dated 15th September 1766. N^o 1240. Granted to William Grimes for 100 Acres" joining John Forsyth and John Smith in Guilford Township.

Report. The above Tract is covered by a Survey of 288 Acres 17 perches made 12 May 1769 on Warrant to John Thompson dated 14 June 1768. and held under said title. - Note. the dotted figure A represents balance of Thompsons Survey. Note. No evidence appears of Grimes Order being executed on the Land or of any person claiming under the same. but it is alledged by an old residenter that the above is the Land intended for Grimes Order. Abraham Hollinger, Joseph Jumbro & Elizabeth Hollingers heirs, owners & occupiers.
