



Situate on Cove Creek at the gap of Dunning's Mountain, partly in Frankstown township Huntingdon County and partly in Greenfield Township Bedford County - containing one hundred and fifty Acres and allowance of six per <sup>cent</sup> - Surveyed for Silas Yerkes on order No 1032 dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August 1766.

The red lines represent part of a Survey made for John Crouse on Warrant dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of July 1798 - This Survey interferes one hundred and fifty Acres with the Silas Yerkes tract. Silas Yerkes conveyed to Robert Callender whose heirs conveyed to John Crouse who obtained the aforesaid Warrant and conveyed to George Myers, who conveyed to George McKee who devised the same to his heirs the present owners.
