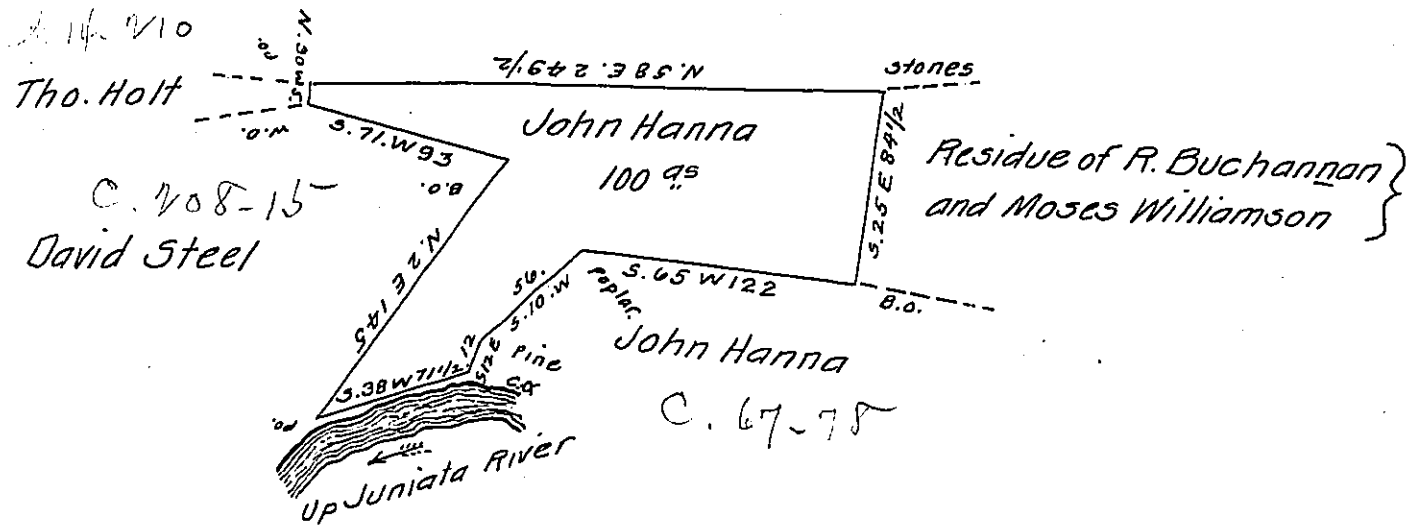


Black Log Mountain
