



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 4th day of May 1833 for W^m McCosky by virtue of an order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 1452 Containing two hundred and twenty eight Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six ¹/₁₀₀ Cent &c.

The same tract of land was surveyed the 12th day of August 1769 for Thomas Lowry in pursuance of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 266. Now owned and in possession of the heirs of James Jenkins Dec^d
