



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County surveyed the 4th day of May 1833 by virtue of an Order granted to Matthew Robinson dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 1892. Containing two hundred and twenty eight Acres with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 12th day of August 1769 for Thomas Lowry in pursuance of his order dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 266. And now Owned and Occupied by the heirs of James Jenkins Decd in right of the Said Thomas Lowry.
