



Situate in White Deer township Union County. Surveyed the 4th September 1836. by Virtue of and Order granted to John McCurdy Dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 436. Containing two Hundred & Ninety Seven Acres & forty perches & the Usual allowance & lays but a small Distance from the River & is represented by the Green lines.

Note. The same land interferes & is included in a Survey made the 21st day of May 1800 for James Parkeson in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 16th day of July 1799. & is represented by the Blue lines
