



Situate in Kelly township Union County. Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1834 for Edward Burd by virtue of his order <sup>dated</sup> the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 428. Containing three Hundred & three acres & one hundred & twenty perches & the usual allowance &c.

Note. The same tract being Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> of August 1769 for John Kelly in pursuance of his order dated the 12<sup>th</sup> of June 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 3335. And now owned and occupied by the Heirs of the Said John Kelly & in his right—
