



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 12th day of November 1832 by virtue of an Order of Survey granted to Neal McCoy dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 252. Containing two hundred & sixty two Acres and twenty perches with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 9th day of October 1769 for George Gall in pursuance of his Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 483. And now Owned & Occupied by John Snook & others in right of the Said George Gall.
