



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 6th day of November 1832 by virtue of an Order granted to Martin Heffelfinger dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 201. Containing three hundred and twenty Acres & Allowance &c.

Note. The same being part of a tract of 619.7 Acres &c. of land Surveyed the 25th day of February 1769 for Captⁿ William Plunket being the Allotment which fell to him on the Division of 8000 Acres Surveyed for the Officers of Col^l Turbut Francis Corps in pursuance of an Order of Survey N^o 1. And now owned & occupied by Martin Dresbuch &c. in right of the Said Captⁿ W^m Plunket.
