



Situate in Hartley township Union County. Surveyed the 19th day of July 1836 by Virtue of an Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 Granted to Henry Summers No 87 Containing Ninety Six Acres & ten perches with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 10th day of May 1784 for John Gopert in pursuance of his Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769 & now owned & occupied by John Sheively & others in right of the said John Gopert.
