



Situate about one mile below Blyth place on the River in White Deer township Union County. Surveyed the 28th day of September 1835 by Virtue of an Order Granted to Hugh Stephens Dated 3^d April 1769. N^o 908. Containing three Hundred & one Acres and Sixty perches & the Usual allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the — day of — 1769 for Michael Deets in pursuance of his Order Dated the 3^d April 1769. N^o 189 & is now owned by John Hoffman & others in right of the Said Mich^l Deets.
