



Situate in West Buffalo township Union County. Surveyed the 22<sup>d</sup> day of April 1836 by Virtue of an Order Granted to James Ennis Jr. dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 947 Containing three Hundred & Six Acres with the Usual allowance &c.  
 Note. The same tract of land was surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> day of June 1771 for Able Pees in pursuance of his Order dated 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 2680 & now owned & occupied by John Ma Gee & others in right of the said Able Pees.
