



Situated on Penns Creek in Hartley township Union County surveyed the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1836. By Virtue of an Order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 939. Granted to Martin Albrecht. Containing two Hundred & eighty Acres and one hundred & fourteen perches with the usual allowance & is represented by the Green lines.

Note. The same interferes & is part of a larger tract which was surveyed for William Douglass the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April 1794 in pursuance of his Warrant Dated the 2<sup>d</sup> April 1794 & now owned by Robert Barber & others in right of the said William Douglass and is represented by the red lines
