



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> day of October 1832 by virtue of an Order granted Jacob Shaffner dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N. 847. Containing three hundred & eight Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent &c.

The same being part of a tract of land which was surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May 1769 for Capt - Lems by virtue of his order dated - day of - 176 - N - . And now Occupied and owned by George Royer in right of the said Capt - Lems.
