



The whole of the above tract is an interference of a tract of 197 acres granted by T & R Penn by patent dated 11<sup>th</sup> Aug<sup>t</sup> 1765, and surveyed on warrant granted 11<sup>th</sup> May 1762, to John Schryer who sold the same to Conrad Dotterer now owned and possessed by his son George Dotterer situate formerly in Germany, now Conowago township Adams County. Witness my hand.
