No 1 represented by dotted lines is part of the draught of a survey made for Joseph Shippen, on order No 1 dated the 1st day of August 1766. This tract interferes two hundred and twenty and three fourths acres with the James Barrett survey. Joseph Shippen, devised the same to Henry Shippen who conveyed to Josiah Blossen and Andrew McFarland the present owners.

No 2. represented by dotted lines is part of a survey made for Joshua Burley on warrant dated the 21st day of May 1793. this survey interferes thirty six and one half acres with the James Barrett tract. Joshua Burley conveyed to James E. Stewart the present owner.
