(On an application granted for 150^{ac} of land on the head of Antetern Creek joining Anne Stacey John Kess & the South Mountain in Antrim township dated the 15th of January 1768 N^o 4701) In pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights.
