



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed application -4644 issued 13th Decr 1767 to Detrick Fahnestock for 100 acres on land in Conowingo township Adams County adjoining Wm Dickson's quarter, Jacob Keagy, Robert Owen & papist priests, and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram.
