Surveyed the 28th of October 1829 (on a warrant granted Francis Oury for 100^{ac} of land joining William Means & Adam Cook, in Antrim township dated the 10th of June 1762.) In pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.
