



Situate in Union township Union county surveyed the 26th day of November 1832 by virtue of a warrant dated the 10th day of February 1755 granted to John Jacques Villars, containing fifty three & fifty eight perches with the usual allowance &c. & is designated by the yellow lines.

Note. The same is included in a tract of land ~~of~~ surveyed the 15th day of August 1769 for John Zeller, in pursuance of an order granted to him dated the 3^d day of April 1769 & No 2204 & designated by the Green lines and now owned by Philip Faust in right of the said John Zeller.
