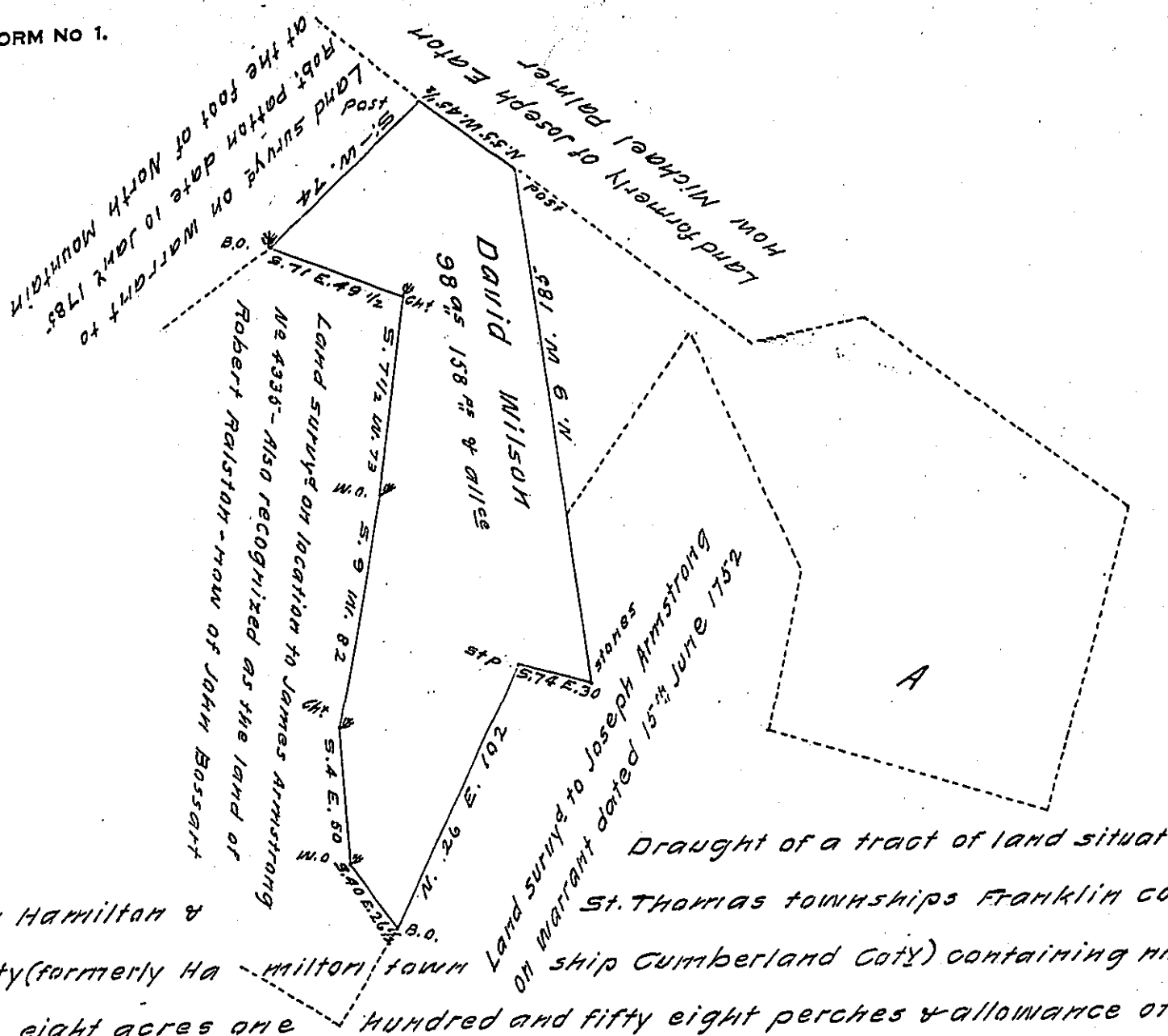


FORM NO 1.



Draught of a tract of land situate in Hamilton & St. Thomas townships Franklin county (formerly Hamilton township Cumberland City) containing ninety eight acres one hundred and fifty eight perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c &c. Located in pursuance of a warrant dated the 19th of July 1770, granted to David Wilson, for 100 acres "joining Robert Ralston, Joseph Armstrong and the North Mountain in Hamilton township."

And by virtue of a contract with the Board of property for ascertaining surveying and returning unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c &c.

Report - The above tract is wholly included in a larger tract of 262 1/2 acres which was surveyed 22d October 1785 on two warrants to Col. Joseph Armstrong, one dated 14th June 1785 the other dated 13th October 1785 which tract is represented in full by the dotted lined figure marked A in addition to the above survey. The above tract is now owned by Frederick Belmicks & Frederick Karper under the title founded on Armstrong's warrants, unseated land.
